For this reason, she joined Accountability Lab, keen on making a difference. As a Program Officer, she led youth engagement programs, most precisely coordinated support for a cohort of youth from diverse sectors with innovative ideas on promoting government accountability and social justice through the “Accountability Incubator”. Similarly, she also led a group of community frontline workers aimed at strengthening democracy through “Civic Action Teams”: citizen and sub-national government engagement programs across the seven provinces in Nepal.

Anti-corruption measures, in order to be effective and long-lasting, should be complemented by the promotion of individual integrity, in a view to ignite a comprehensive and institutionalized long-term solution.
